ABOUT VEI

VEI equals Water Operator Partnerships (WOPs)

WOPs are demand driven partnerships between water and sanitation utilities on a non-profit basis. WOPs aim to capacitate employees, improve operational performance, enhance financial viability and raise resilience towards climate change of water utilities. WOPs work through peer-topeer exchange of knowledge, experience, skills and acquired competencies in an absorptive setting (enabling environment).

VEI is the world's leading promotor and implementor of WOPs

Established in 2004 by Dutch water operators, VEI has developed into an effective organisation with a stable annual turnover of € 20 million that is engaged in implementing WOPs with dozens of water operators over more than 20 countries worldwide, capacitating hundreds of employees from water utilities, and providing over 300,000 people with improved access to water services, mostly from low-income areas in Africa, Asia and South America. The core business of VEI is to provide operational expert support via short, medium and long term assignments to its partners. This form of capacity development is unique and connects water operators in its core processes: production, transport, distribution and sales of potable water to customers.

Key elements of its capacity development program are: 1. built capacity at individual and organisational level 2. enhance operational efficiency 3. manage assets over their entire life cycle.
